LURES: Jigheads from 1/8 to 3/8 oz (we use 1/4 oz. jigs)

3"-4" Twister tails or other plastics

Lindy Rigs or live bait spinners (we use 3/8 oz egg sinkers) Live Bait (Night Crawlers / Leeches) or Berkely Gulp

Rat-L-Traps, Storm Thin Fins

kar-L-iraps, Storm inin rins

Rapala Husky Jerk, Shad Rap, or similar minnow imitating lures

COLORS: Chartreuse, Orange, White, Yellow, & Perch patterns

Northerns: ROD: Medium to heavy action

LINE: 10 to 14 lb. test
LURES: Mepps Spinners #5

Spoons (Williams Wablers, Red Eyes, 5 of diamonds)

Large Rapala, Storm, or Salmo crankbaits

7" Suick (9" if you're using a heavy enough rod)

Spinner baits / buzz baits 6-12" Steel or Titanium Leaders

Additional Tackle: Personal life jacket (we have 50 life jackets at the lodge)

Fishing net (we have a few at the lodge)

Rope / Nylon stringer (we have a few at the lodge)

Fillet knife

Portable depth finders can also be handy

Gear: Sleeping bag
